### Our Guides and Sled Dogs

Mushers hired are experienced with sled dogs. Many are accomplished mushers who have received Vet's choice, Sportsmanship and Humanitarian Awards during winter sled dog racing events.

Sled dog kennels are all vetted through our extensive contacts

Sled dogs are individually evaluated.

Each sled dog receives a vet exam certifying they are healthy, in good physical condition, current on vaccinations and care schedules

Sled dogs are screened to ensure they are well socialized



## Veterinary care

Is available throughout the season.

Staff Veterinarian.

Mushers trained with Dog First Aid & CPR.

Camp is equipped with an extensive veterinary tech level emergency kit.

On site staff with certification ranging from Wilderness First Aid to EMT.

Vet consultation for any concern is available 24 hours a day 7 days a week.

Weekly communication between musher and veterinary staff with concerns and updates is mandatory.

Monthly on site veterinarian visit with a written report
